## SCOPE OF SERVICE EXPERIENCE

# What is a Certified Occupancy Specialist (COS)?

The Certified Occupancy Specialist designation is the most recognized certification for Housing and Urban Development Housing. The following is a highlight of the requirements.

- Education through National Center for Housing Management courses, a minimum of 40 hours of course work.
- Examination show competency in adherence to HUD requirements for income determinations, eligibility requirements, Fair Housing laws, and government regulated inspections for both the physical property and administrative record-keeping at the site level.

# What is a Certified Apartment Manager (CAM)?

The Certified Apartment Manager designation is indicative of an individual who has a well versed knowledge of multi-family management skills. The following is a highlight of the requirements.

- Education through National Apartment Association courses, a minimum of 40 hours of course work.
- Experience— a minimum of 12 months of onsite property management experience.
- Examination show competency in all aspects of onsite management including but not limited to; financial reporting, budget preparations, resident retention, net operating income maximization and adherence to Fair Housing regulations.



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
